Week 1 - Lessons from Rio de Janeiro, Brazil

Rio de Janeiro (in Brazil) was a pioneer in the development of Smart and Sustainable Cities, led by Mayor Eduardo Paes. He gave an excellent TED Talk in 2012 on the 4 Commandments of Cities which are important lessons for cities of the future.

The video is about 12 minutes long, but it is worth listening. However, here's the ONE MINUTE READ.

1) A City of the Future has to be <u>environmentally friendly</u>.

Find open spaces. The temperature of the city will drop 2 to 3 degrees centigrade.

2) A City of the Future has to deal with mobility and integration of its people.

Rio moved from 18% to 63% of its population to use public transport.

3) A City of the Future has to be <u>socially integrated</u>.

Rio had 6.3million inhabitants, with more than 20% (1.4million) living in favelas (slums). Move in basic services (education and health of high quality) and infrastructure into the favelas.

4) A City of the Future has to use <u>technology</u> to be present.

IBM assisted Rio to implement their City Operations Centre, with video and IOT Integration.

5) Lessons for Singapore too - Smart Nation announced at the National Day Rally in 2014 when the Prime Minister showed the Rio de Janeiro Ops Centre.
