Nashville Engagement About Urban Flooding

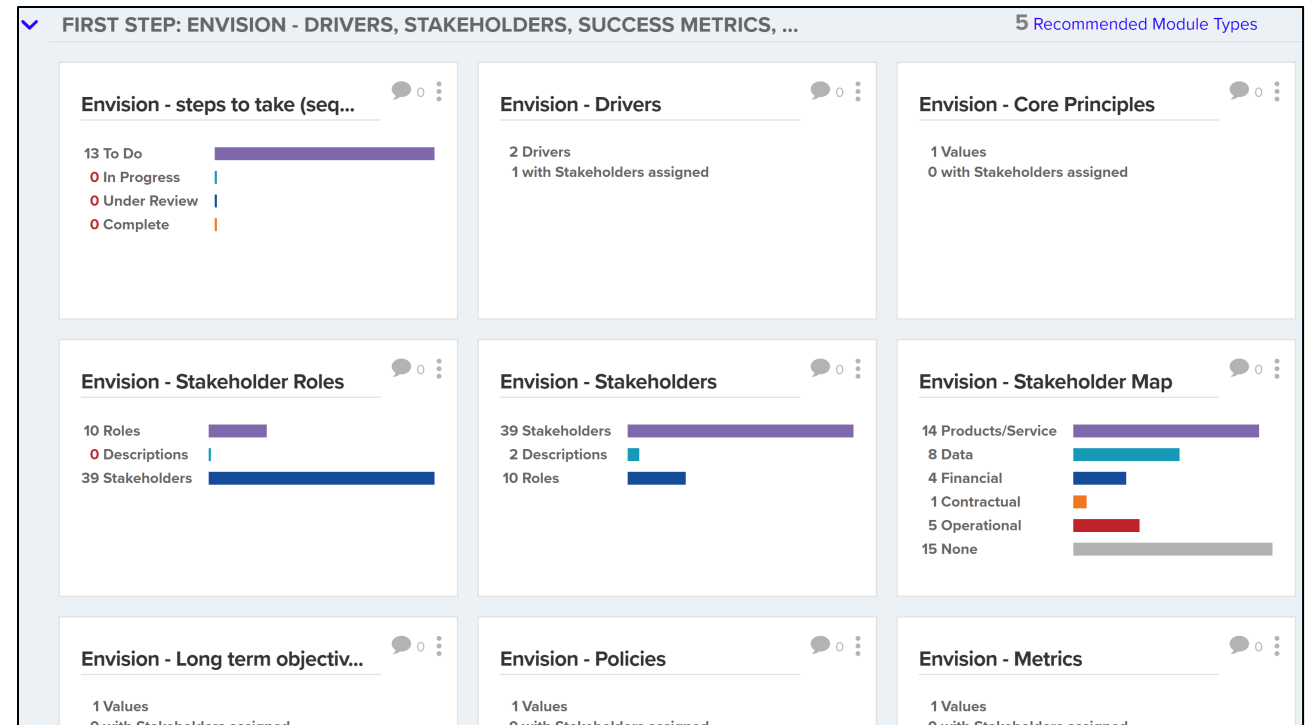
Fully digital workshop event series!
